


Shout to the Most High, all the earth, break into joyous songs of praise! Sing praise to Yahweh with the harp, with the harp and melodious singing!

With trumpets and the blast of the shofar, raise a shout to Yahweh, Ruler of All. Let the sea and all within it thunder; the world and all its peoples.


Let the rivers clap their hands and the hills ring out their joy before Yahweh, who comes to judge the earth, who will rule the world with justice and its peoples with equity.


