QUESTION OF THE WEEK – February 22, 2026

How does Satan tempt us with shortcuts to achieve good things
(e.g., getting ahead, having influence)?

Matthew 4:1-11 - Matthew Thompson

Then Jesus was led into the desert by the Spirit, to be tempted by the Devil. After fasting for forty days and forty nights, Jesus was hungry. Then the tempter approached and said, "If you are the Only Begotten, command these stones to turn into bread." Jesus replied, "Scripture has it, We live not on bread alone but on every utterance that comes from the mouth of God.' "

Next the Devil took Jesus to the Holy City, set him on the parapet of the Temple and said, "If you are the Only Begotten, throw yourself down. Scripture has it, 'God will tell the angels to take care of you; with their hands they will support you that you may never stumble on a stone.'" Jesus answered, "Scripture also says, 'Do not put God to the test.' "
